When an observed holiday falls on your regular collection day, collections will be delayed by one day for the remainder of the week. For example, Thanksgiving Day falls on Thursday. Residences normally collected on Thursday will be collected on Friday. Friday's normal week collections will move to Saturday.

  - Fourth of July (observed July 5th)

Place all trash and non-recyclables (items not listed below) in the Burgundy cart

Examples of items to be placed in Green cart:

- Mixed paper: (mail, envelopes, magazines, catalogs, writing paper, paperback books, paper bags, greeting cards, wrapping paper)
- Thin cardboard: (shoe, cereal, pasta, gift, cake mix and toothpaste boxes, toilet paper rolls, paper egg cartons)
- Newspapers (including ads & inserts); Corrugated cardboard (flattened and folded to fit in cart)

Examples of items to be placed in Blue cart:

- Tin/aluminum, scrap metal (aluminum & tin cans, foil pie plates, empty steel aerosol cans, empty latex paint cans, toasters, irons)
- Glass bottles & jars (mayonnaise jars, beer & wine bottles, applesauce jars)
- Plastic bottles and jugs: (soda & juice bottles, salad dressing bottles, shampoo bottles)
- Plastic bottles and jugs: (milk jugs, detergent bottles, juice bottles, fabric softener and bleach bottles)
- Milk cartons and drink boxes (milk & juice cartons, cream and creamer containers)

NON-RECYCLABLE: Paper towels, napkins & facial tissues, tissue & foil wrapping paper, frozen food boxes, soda or beer packaging, soap or laundry detergent boxes, any dirty, greasy or plastic coated cardboard.
